Geography


As geographers we will...

As scientists we will...



- Explore materials and their properties.

- Read non-fiction books about weather
- Write fact files about hot and cold places.

Mathematics:

As mathematicians we will...

- Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0 and in 10's from any number, backwards and forwards.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations and mentally, including a two-digit number and ones; two-digit number and tens; two two-digit numbers; adding three one-digit numbers.
- Count amounts of money in pounds and pence.
- Make different amounts of money.
- Find the total of different amounts of money.
