## Minutes:

CG asked MPs their opinion on if children should have to wear school uniform at Beaumont. The children voted 5/8 to keep school uniform. JN expressed that uniform made us look smart. AK said that it helped us to represent school, KJ liked that we don't have to make a choice about what to wear in the morning. MPatel liked having special occasion days to wear non-uniform as this felt more special.

CG likened our school uniform to having to wear smart attire as an MP and it was important that people saw you dressed smartly for that role. CG also made the point that lots of jobs in society require people to wear a special uniform so that we can recognise people's roles e.g. police, nurses etc.

CG prompted MPs to think of reasons not to wear a school uniform. JN said that it wasn't always comfortable, ES said she wished she could have a wider choice of what to wear day to day, IC expressed that he did not like the green colour of our current uniform and prefers orange.

CG made the point to the children that if children in school have to wear uniform, should teaching staff wear it too? It was decided that School Parliament will discuss this during the whole school debate on Friday.
