# Maths



- New scheme called **Power Maths** – children may have already mentioned it.
- It follows a structure of: starter, discover, share, think together, practice, challenge & then a reflect section.



# Reading

- Children need to be accessing **Reading Plus** numerous times a week. The lessons are averaging out at around 11 mins a session meaning they are easily fit into a weekday/weekend. Children will be awarded 5 points if they have read 5 times a week.

# Good To Be Green

- All children start on green every day.
- Moved to a warning card if spoken to several times during a lesson. Children have the chance to go back to green once they have corrected their behaviour. If a child is going onto a warning card frequently, there will be a phone call home.
- Yellow and red cards – phone calls home & no Friday treat.
- Friday afternoon → good to be green reward time, in class, for staying on green all week.



# Drop off & Pick up

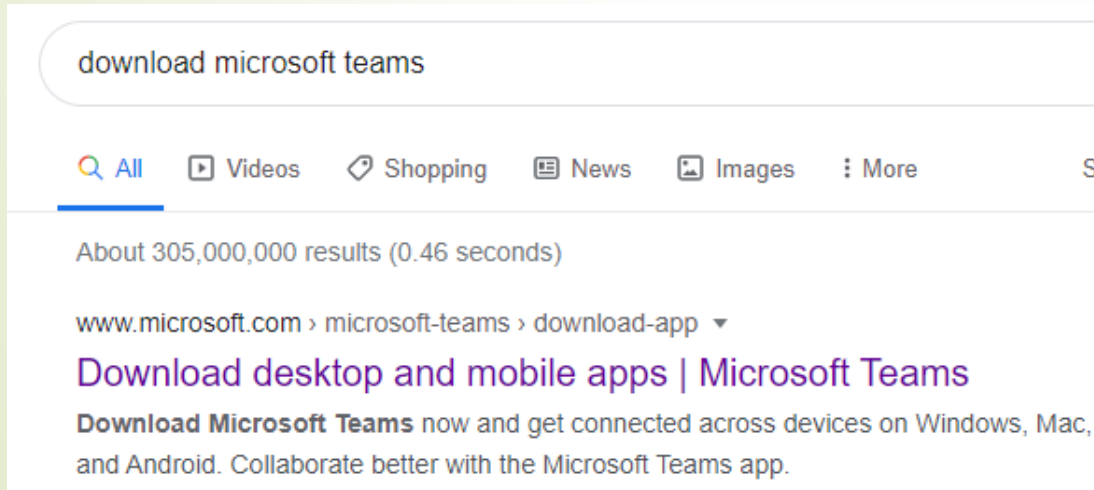
