



Dear Parent,

Your child is self-isolating due to either someone in your family having tested positive, you having just returned from a country and you must quarantine for 14 days, NHS Track and Trace having informed you that your child must self-isolate, or your child having attended a venue and then being told they must self-isolate due to a close and direct contact with a person with a positive case of Coronavirus.

Your child can return to school 14 days after the date of the test where the positive result was given. For example, if the test was taken on the 1st of the month, your child can return to school on the 15th of the month.

Meanwhile, we want to provide your child with high quality learning at home. Unfortunately, we cannot provide live online learning as we would in the event of a full bubble closure. Instead, we have produced 10 high quality daily tasks for your child. These can be found on our website:
