Maths:



No playdough?
No problem! Use
this simple recipe
to create your own!

- 8 tbsp plain flour
- 2 tbsp table salt
- 60ml warm water
- food colouring
- 1 tbsp vegetable oil

Can you compare fractions with different denominators? If you fancy doing a practical activity that will help you, use playdough to represent different fractions and record comparisons in your book. Use $<$, $>$ and $=$ when comparing them. Take pictures, or maybe even make a short video to explain what you know, and post on Class Dojo.

1. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. In a separate bowl mix together the water, a few drops of food colouring and the oil.
2. Pour the coloured water into the flour mix and bring together with a spoon.
3. Dust a work surface with a little flour and turn out the dough. Knead together for a few minutes to form a smooth, pliable dough. If you want a more intense colour you can work in a few extra drops of food colouring.

English:

Can you find out the meaning of 'photosynthesis'? Write it in your own words or draw a picture to explain it.
