Read this poem about kindness.

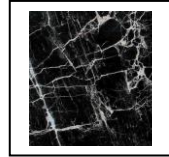
A good way to start understanding a text is to see if there are any words you are not sure about the meaning of. Find the meaning of '**deeds**' in the dictionary and record it.
