



Computer Science – Variables

Design, write and debug programs that accomplish specific goals, including controlling or simulating physical systems; solve problems by decomposing them into smaller parts. Use sequence, selection, repetition in programs; work with variables and various forms of input and output. Use logical reasoning to explain how some simple algorithms work and to detect and correct errors in algorithms and programs. Select, use and combine a variety of software (including internet services) on a range of digital devices to design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals, including collecting, analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information.

Animals including humans

- The circulatory system

Working Scientifically

- Know how to set up an enquiry based investigation e.g. what is the relationship between oxygen and blood?
- Know which type of investigation is needed to suit particular scientific enquiry e.g. looking at the relationship between pulse and exercise
- Keep an on-going record of new scientific words & use these regularly in future scientific write ups.
- Use diagrams, as & when necessary, to support writing & be confident enough to present findings orally in front of the class.
- Present information related to scientific enquiries in a range of ways including using IT.
