Properties and changes in materials
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compare properties of everyday materials Soluble/ dissolving Reversible and irreversible substances
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compare and group materials based on their properties (e.g. hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity, [electrical & thermal], and response to magnets Know and explain how a material dissolves to form a solution Know and show how to recover a substance from a solution Know and demonstrate how some materials can be separated (e.g. through filtering, sieving and evaporating) Know and demonstrate that some changes are reversible and some are not Know how some changes result in the formation of a new material and that this is usually irreversible
Working scientifically
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set up an investigation when it is appropriate e.g. finding out which materials dissolve or not Make predictions based on information gleaned from investigations Be clear about what has been found out from recent enquiry and can relate this to other enquiries, where appropriate Their explanations set out clearly why something has happened and its possible impact on other things Use other scientific instruments as needed e.g. thermometer, rain gauge, spring scales (for measuring Newtons)
