Remote Home Learning

I read a quote from a leading doctor in Early Years Learning this week, and it made me think about what we are all being asked to do:

"This is not 'home schooling'. Home schooling is a conscious decision made by some parents having researched that option. This is **emergency education**, during lockdown, while surviving a pandemic. So let's lower our expectations of ourselves a little bit."

Lateral Flow Testing in School

At some point this week, we will begin conducting Lateral Flow testing in school. This involves every adult in school being tested twice weekly for C19. This does offer us more protection by detecting positive asymptomatic people early, and reduces the transmission rate. However, it may lead to disruption. I just wanted to keep parents of children who are in school at the minute in the loop, so they are fully aware of the increased chances of bubble closures. This should not affect remote home learning too much, but as always, I may ask for your patience and support if lateral flow testing increases the possibility of disruption.

School Places for KW or Vulnerable Children

If your child already has a place in school because they fall into the category of a child with an EHCP, are vulnerable or have parents who are keyworkers, can I ask you to always be reconsidering if you can reduce the days your child is in school? If you think
